- 4.3 Boats will be equally divided among the schools by the SMYC sailing instructors

# 5. Registration

Registration is required at 9.00 am Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> May at the SMYC.

#### 6. Race areas

Racing will be in the lagoon near the airport runway, next to the causeway bridge or outside in the Simpson Bay.

# 7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration and online at the Regatta website before Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> of May.

# 8. Scoring

- 8.1. When fewer than 5 races have been completed a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.
- 8.2. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boats series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 8.3. Scoring will be by the CHIPS 3 High point System which awards scores based on class size.

#### 9. Prizes

- 9.1. Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each class.
- 9.2. Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd school team based on the total weighted score of the 3 highest scoring entries per school.
- 9.3. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Race Committee and/or Organizer.
