1. Entry

1.1. Entry fees listed are for the full series excluding separate Regattas. Boats may enter the Series for individual Keelboat Day racing at an entry fee of US \$50 per day and Jeanneau 20's at US \$40.

1.2. Boats can enter on the website: www.smyc.com/keelboat-series

1.3 The event is open to all boats with Valid CSA rating certificates and the 2 mentioned one design classes:

CSA 1 Monohull	0.820 – 1.0	CSA Main Rating Monohull
CSA 2 Monohull	0.700 – 0.819	CSA Main Rating Monohull
CSA Multihull	-	CSA Multihull Rating Rule Entry is open to any multihull over 20 feet that is not normally pulled up a beach by the crew.
Diam 24	One design	Diam 24 class one design with SMYC Local Club Safety Adjustments.
Jeanneau SunFast 20	One design	Agreed SMYC local club Sun Fast 20 One design rules.

1.4 Classes: Sailing committee decides at the yachts first entry of the series in what class the boat will be sailing. The sailing committee's decision will be final.

1.5 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply:
For all classes the minimum amount of boats shall be two (2).

2. Registration

Formal registration will take place Friday Prior to the event at SMYC. Unless a boat has entered for the whole series.

Information about individual race days will be published on the Entry and Results Page in on www.smyc.com/keelboat-series

3. Courses

Keelboat Day courses will be a mixture of windward-leeward and fixed-mark courses starting and finishing in or near Simpson Bay. Courses will be decided on the race day by the race officer and will be adjusted based on conditions and entry.

4. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be posted on smyc.com.

The SMYC Standard Sailing instructions for Keelboat and Multihull Club Racing will be in place.

5. Scoring

5.1 Low-point scoring will apply.

5.2 The final score of each entrant will be made up of the total final scores in each of the constituent events.

5.3 An entrant not competing in any of the events will be scored with number of registered entries plus one.

5.4 A boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding the worst score when five events are completed. When less than five events are completed there will be no discard

5.5 When a boat is not competing in a specific series, she will score the number of registered competitors +1.

8. Prizes:

Overall prizes will be awarded to the first three boats in each class over the whole Keelboat Series

9. Classes: Class allocations will be made at 6pm on the Friday before the first day of racing for the series. The order of starts will be advised verbally and on radio by the race officer.
