

ANGUILLA



Clearing in & out of Anguilla is obligatory

Yachts must proceed directly to Road Bay and clear in at the Customs and Immigration office at Sandy Ground.

Office opening hours: 08:30AM - 12PM, 13PM - 16PM, 7 days a week

You will be asked for 5 copies of the crew list and may be asked for the same of the clearance from the last port of call.

If staying less than 24 hours, one can clear Customs in and out at the same time.

Because of serious concern over drug traffic, yachts must be sure to clear in properly. Failure to do so could result in a fine, and the boat being confiscated.

Every boat has to pay port dues, based on gross tonnage - under 20grt 19\$US, over 20grt 34\$US.

Also, please remember to be nicely attired (must wear shirt / shoes etc)

Passport

All crewmembers are required to present a valid passport during the check-in process

Water taxi

Supplied by the Instructors of the Junior Sailing Program of the Anguilla Sailing Association.

Clearing in & out of St. Barths is obligatory (Open 7am-6pm)

Clearing in & out can be done on-line maximum 24 hours before hand.

1. Contact the Port of Gustavia two hours prior to arrival -VHF 12

On arrival in St. Barths:

2. end a representative/captain of the boat ashore with: all the passports / Name of Vessel and the Registration Number from the on-line registration.

At the Capitainerie: Open the link http://clairances.portdegustavia.com/home.php?ins-new_clairance_ent.php on their Computers-and complete. If staying 24hrs, clearing in and out can be completed at the same time.

Anchoring is not free. They have high & low season rates (HS & LS), paid in euros upon departure. Fee structure is based on length of boat and length of stay.
