5. Scoring

- 5.1 Low-point scoring will apply.
- 5.2 The final score of each entrant will be made up of the total final scores in each of the constituent events.
- 5.3 An entrant not competing in any of the events will be scored with number of registered entries plus one.
- 5.4~ A boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding the worst score when
- five events are completed. When less than five events are completed there will be no discard
- 5.5 When a boat is not competing in a specific series, she will score the number of registered competitors +1.

6. Prizes

6.1 Overall prizes will be awarded to the first three boats in each class over the whole Keelboat Series
