1. REGATTA

1.1 This regatta consists of the following races: Race Day 1, Race Day 2.

2. CLASSES AND ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 CSA Keelboat: Entry is open to any keelboat whose primary basis for stability is fixed ballast.
- 2.2 Multihull: Entry is open to any multihull over 20 feet that is not normally pulled up a beach by the crew.
- 2.3 Diam 24: One design class.
- 2.4 Sun Fast 20: One design class.

3. REGISTRATION

- 3.1 Formal registration will take place on Friday, June 20 at SMYC.
- 3.2 Information about individual race days will be published on the Entry and Results Page: [smyc.com/...](http://smyc.com/)

4. RACE AREA AND COURSES

- 4.1 The first race on Saturday, June 21 will start in Simpson Bay, Sint Maarten and finish in Road Bay, Anguilla.
- 4.2 All other races will be in or around the Road Bay area.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 Sailing Instructions will be provided at registration and may be available on the regatta website prior to.

6. SCORING

- 6.1 Low-point scoring will apply.
- 6.2 The final score of each entrant will be made up of the total final scores in each of the constituent events.
- 6.3 An entrant not competing in any of the events will be scored with number of registered entries plus one.
- 6.4 A boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding the worst score when five events are completed. When less than five events are completed there will be no discard.

7. RULES

- 7.1. The regatta is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 7.2. The regatta is also governed by
 - a) For any class identified as a 'CSA' class, the *CSA Rating Rules*
- 7.3. The Sailing Instructions may also change rules.

8. ADVERTISING

- 8.1. Boats may be required to display advertising supplied by the organizing authority.

9. ENTRY

- 9.1. The regatta is open to boats in the classes listed.
- 9.2. Boats may register on the regatta website.

10. FEES

- 10.1. The fee for entry is \$150 per boat

11. IDENTIFICATION

- 11.1. All boats shall provide their sail number or other identification at registration.
- 11.2. If bow numbers are issued by the Race Committee, a deposit as stated in the NOR will be charged, payable at registration and refunded when numbers are returned within thirty days after the regatta.

12. CLASSES

- 12.1. Classes may be subdivided or combined at the discretion of the Race Committee and not subject to protest.

13. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 13.1. The Protest Committee may, at its discretion, impose an alternative penalty in lieu of disqualification for any infringement, including safety requirements, with the exception of an infringement of the Racing Rules parts 1 and 2. This changes RRS 64.
- 13.2. For protests involving an alleged breach of a Rule of Part 2, arbitration will be held prior to a protest hearing if all parties agree. This changes Part 5, Section B of the Rules.
- 13.3. A boat that could have taken a penalty under Rule 44.1 but has not taken such a penalty may accept a 30% exoneration penalty prior to arbitration or a 40% penalty prior to the opening of a protest hearing about the incident calculated in the same way as a scoring penalty under Rule 44.3. This changes Rule A4.2.

14. PRIZES

- 14.1. Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each class.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 15.1. Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16. PHOTOGRAPHIC AND MEDIA RIGHTS

- 16.1. The entrant and all crew grant the organizers the right to use their name and image and that of the entered boat in all media for the purposes of editorial or advertising.
